Why?

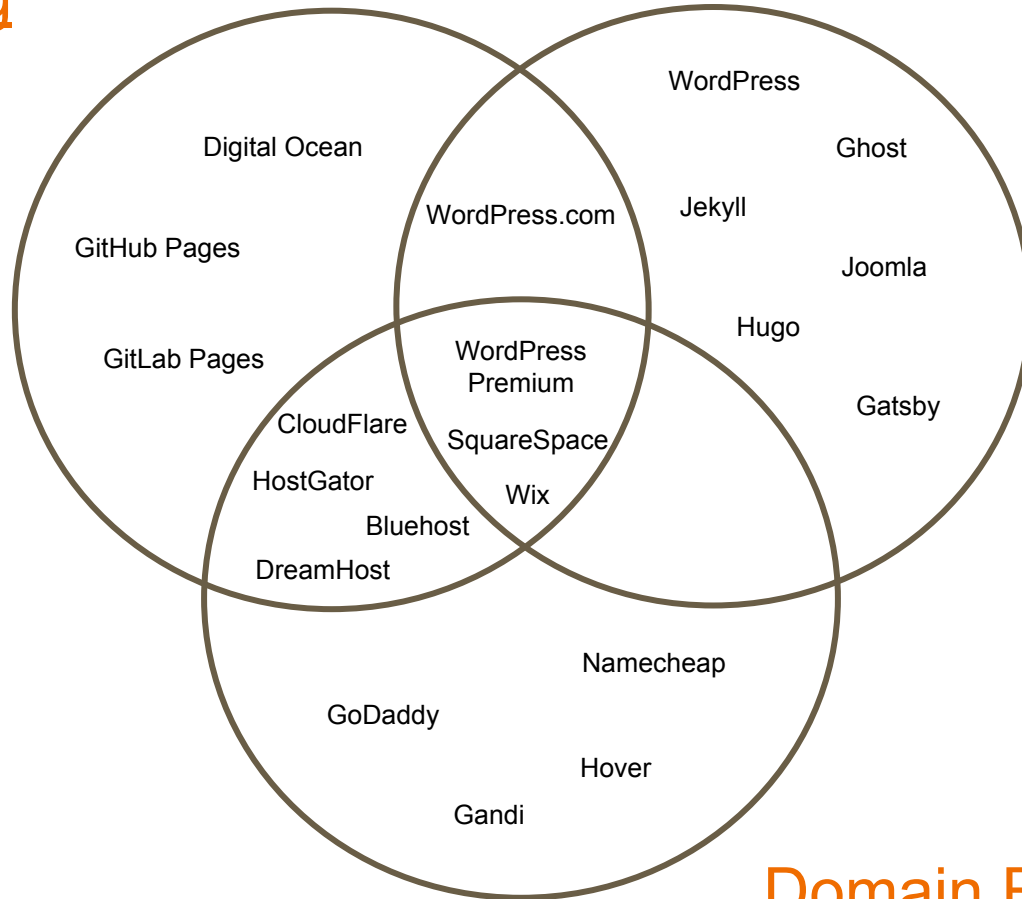
- “Dynamic” CV
 - Track your accomplishments
 - ...while publicizing them
 - More broad than resume
 - Back up important job-related files
 - Low-stakes way to learn how the web works

Dynamic vs. Static Websites

Dynamic

- Use databases to generate pages and content
- Software is usually a **Content Management System** (CMS)
- Good for it-just-works, minimal design intervention
- e.g. WordPress, SquareSpace, Joomla, Ghost

Static

- No databases to create pages and content
- Software is usually a **Static Site Generator**
- Good for learning web basics, customization
- e.g. Jekyll, Hugo, Gatsby
